phosphorylation site of Thr189.

Uniprot: Q15831

Description: ubiquitously expressed kinase of the CAMKL family with a tumor

suppressor activity. Phosphorylates AGS3 (activator of G-protein signaling 3) GPR domains, regulating the interaction of GPR-containing proteins with G-proteins. Strongest expression in testis and fetal liver. Mutations in LKB1

lead to the Peutz-Jeghers cancer syndrome.

<code>IMPORTANT:</code> For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1% TBS, 0.1% Tween®20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.

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
