Purification: The antiserum was purified by peptide affinity chromatography using

SulfoLinkTM Coupling Resin (Thermo Fisher Scientific).

Immunogen: A synthesized peptide derived from human p73, corresponding to a region

within the internal amino acids.

Description: p73 a protein of the p53 family of proteins. p73, like p53, may have tumor

suppressor activity, but its multiple isoforms possess different and sometimes opposing functions. Participates in the apoptotic response to DNA damage. Phosphorylated in a cell cycle-dependent manner and

negatively regulated by CDKs.

<code>IMPORTANT:</code> For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1X TBS, 0.1% Tween@20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.
